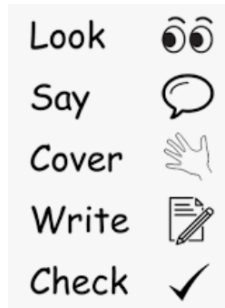


Reading
