If you feel that your child already knows these off by heart (i.e. they can randomly answer all multiplication and corresponding division facts, e.g. $3 \times 7 = 21$, $7 \times 3 = 21$, $21 \div 3 = 7$, $21 \div 7 = 3$) then they could move on to x 12.

P.E this term will continue to be on a Thursday afternoon (games with Moving Matters). Please ensure that your child has suitable clothing for P.E, especially trainers or plimsolls.

On Friday mornings, we will go swimming at Brixton Rec. Children will need to bring in swimming suit, goggles, hat and towel on those days. We would be grateful for one adult helper each week.
