



Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to our final half term of year 6! The year has flown by and we are so proud of all of the work that your children have put into preparing not only for the SATS but to begin their secondary school journey. The hard work does not stop here however – this term will be full of Maths projects, art projects, preparing for transition, the PGL trip and scriptwriting, scene and prop building and rehearsing for our end of year performance.

Topic: For our topic this term we will be finishing off The Abbasids as with all of the excitement of SATS we weren't quite able to complete all of the exciting work we had planned.

Science & RSHE: This term in Science and Relationships, Sex and Health Education, Year 6 children will learn about puberty and reproduction, communication and consent, families, conception and pregnancy, and how to build respectful relationships both in person and online. These lessons help children understand the changes they may experience as they grow up, develop confidence, and learn how to communicate respectfully, make safe choices, and maintain healthy relationships. They are taught in an age-appropriate way and provide children with important knowledge and skills to support their wellbeing and prepare them for the future. There are elements of this topic that are statutory, as parents and carers, you do have the option to opt out of lesson 1: 'Puberty and Reproduction' and lesson 3: 'Families, Conception and Pregnancy.' If you would like to do so, please could we ask that you put this in writing to the office via email before Friday 12th June. Make £5 Grow: This is an educational programme where each child is loaned £5 to start a mini business. Over the weeks it will help the children understand saving, spending, and how to feel happier and more confident about managing money and spark creativity and builds vital life skills such as problem-solving, risk awareness, and teamwork.
