## Year 1 Newsletter – Summer Term 2

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back! I hope you all had an enjoyable half term break. It's the last few weeks of this school year and we will both be very sad to see Year 1 go! We have thoroughly enjoyed teaching your children and have been really thrilled by the progress that they have made. Here is what Year 1 will be focusing on this term. Our final topic is 'Toys around the world'. Please see the attached curriculum map for information about what the children will be learning this term. As part of our Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) learning, this term we will cover the sex and relationships education (SRE) and drugs lessons for Year 1. We will be looking at the differences between boys and girls, naming body parts and learning how to look after ourselves and each other. If you have any questions regarding this please feel free to come and speak to me. Jess Edwards will continue to cover the class every Wednesday afternoon to deliver music lessons and work with coach Chris to cover tennis lessons in PE.



### Reading

In Year 1, children will continue to be heard reading at least twice a week; once with a teacher as part of their guided reading session and once with a teaching assistant. Please try to hear your child read on a daily basis and use their reading journals as a place to record their responses to the stories that they read to you or their thoughts on stories that you read to them. This can be a short 10 minute session but it will make a huge impact on their progress in literacy. When your child needs a new reading book please place their book bags in the Year 1 book box for Mrs Bugembe to collect and change. Every Friday the children will be encouraged to change their reading books if they haven't already done so during the week. If you are able to come in to listen to children read during the school day please come and let us know as we always appreciate the extra help.

### P.E



P.E lessons will continue to take place every **Wednesday** afternoon (outdoor) with coach Chris for tennis lessons and **Thursday** morning (outdoor) with coach Sarj from Moving Matters. Please make sure that your child has the appropriate full P.E kit (including plimsolls or trainers) on both days. As the weather is unpredictable, it would be preferable if the children brought in tracksuit bottoms to wear so that they don't get too cold when having their outdoor PE sessions.

### Home learning

The **family learning maths challenge** will continue to be given to the children every Friday. These challenges should be completed and returned to school by the following Friday or earlier if possible. Every Friday, the children will also be given a set of **spellings** that they need to learn at home for the week. We will have our informal spelling challenges in class on the following Friday. This will give the children the chance to learn and practise some of the key spelling patterns they need to be confident in by the time they leave Year 1.

The children will also be given a **topic-based project** to complete around the theme of 'Toys around the world'. This homework project gives the children a chance to practise and perfect skills that they are learning in the classroom and to further explore their class topic independently. Please encourage and support your children when completing their project.

### School uniform

Please ensure your child is wearing the correct uniform. Shoes should be dark and smart. Earrings should be small studs only. Please make sure that **ALL** school clothes and kit are clearly labelled to minimise loss. Don't forget to have a look in the Infant lost property box if anything does go missing. If your child wears shoes that require them to tie laces, please help them to learn how to tie them up at home as they regularly become loose during the course of the school day and it can be a challenge to tie up 30 pairs of shoes throughout the day!
