We will be linking ART to the above topics and also to MATHEMATICS as we will be learning about shape and fractions.

Home Learning

Please could all children read with an adult every day at home for at least 10 minutes.

All children will bring home a list of spellings to learn every Monday. I will assess the children the following Monday through a dictation with the weekly spellings in. All spellings are taken from the phonics the children are covering in class that week.

The homework project this half term is linked to SCIENCE and will be to create a model of a habitat for a favourite animal. Please could all models be in school on Monday 24th May.

With the weather getting warmer, please could I suggest that your child has a sun hat to wear when outside and sun screen either in school or applied before school.

Could all children please bring a filled water bottle from home every day. The children will have the opportunity to re fill their bottle during the day.
