Our topic for this half term is 'The Polar Region'. We will be using a method of learning known as the Mantle of the Expert which will allow children to immerse themselves in the experience of arctic explorers. We will be looking at the geographical topography of the region and discussing the impact that climate change is having on this important area of the world.
