Writing - Write effectively and coherently for different purposes, drawing on reading to inform vocabulary and grammar; **make simple additions, revisions and proof reading corrections to writing.**

Sentence construction - capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks, commas, apostrophes, begin to use brackets; join clauses with or, and, but, when, if, that, because; use past and present tense correctly

To write with purpose and for an audience. ..Be able to write in a range of styles, e.g letters, stories, instructions.

Handwriting – form all lower and upper case letters correctly and use spacing that reflects the size of the letters; use correct diagonal and horizontal strokes to join handwriting.

Reading - Read and listen to a variety of different fiction and non-fiction texts; read with increasing accuracy and be able to sound out unfamiliar words confidently; make sense of reading and be able to correct inaccurate reading; answer questions and talk about what has happened so far in what has been read; predict what might happen next in a story.
