Topic: Inspirational People

Science

Animals including humans

- Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat
- Identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement

Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation:

- Using a range of punctuation correctly including full stops, capital letters and commas.
- Use conjunctions to extend sentences.
- Use adjectives and adverbs to add interest.
- Past tense verbs.
- Consonants and vowels.
- Spellings: -ey, -ear, homophones and near homophones.

Reading:

- Read and understand a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts.
- Make sense of what we read and discuss it with peers.

Writing:

- Describe ourselves.
- Reviews of our favourite books.
- Speech writing inspired by Martin Luther King.
- Biography writing: Ruby Bridges.
- Tar Beach by Faith Ringgold: poetry writing and setting description.

Numeracy

Mental Calculation:

- Times and division facts x 2, 3, 6.
- Counting in 4, 8, 50, 10 and 100.
- Double and halve odd and even 2 digit numbers.
- Name and recognise properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Main topics:

- Place Value:
 - Represent and partition numbers to 100 and 1000.
 - Compare and order numbers to 1000.
- Addition and Subtraction:
 - 1's, 10's and 100's.
 - Two numbers with and without exchange.
- Multiplication and Division:
 - Multiples of 2, 5 and 10.
 - Multiply and divide by 3 and 4.
